Dear County Partners:

The Department of Driver Services (DDS) is now the state agency responsible for the testing and issuance of driver's licenses and Georgia Identification Cards. The Department has undergone many changes. For the most part, our locations and hours have remained the same.

However, DDS now **only** deals with licensing issues. The motor vehicle tag and title function was transferred to the Department of Revenue. Please take a moment to be sure that your county website reflects the new information. All references to the Department of Motor Vehicle Safety (DMVS) should be eliminated. In many cases, the DMVS website is still posted and referring citizens to a website that will be eliminated shortly. The new website is [www.dds.ga.gov](http://www.dds.ga.gov). As always, citizens can also find state services through [www.georgia.gov.com](http://www.georgia.gov.com).

DDS has implemented many new online services: license and ID renewal, initiating an address change, accessing and/or printing a copy of your driving history. Customers may also access the most recent copy of the **Georgia Driver's Manual** and take a practice written road rules test. I am attaching a brochure outlining these services.
