

WATERING SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE JUNE 10, 2009

On June 10, 2009, Governor Perdue announced that due to significant rainfall and improved water supplies, the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has issued a non-drought schedule for outdoor water use. Under a non-drought schedule, EPD drought management guidelines allow outdoor water use three days a week on assigned days using odd and even numbered addresses. Odd-numbered addresses are allowed to water on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays. Even-numbered and un-numbered addresses are allowed to water on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays. Water use may occur at any time of the day on the assigned days. However, landscape watering is discouraged between 10 am and 4 pm because of its limited effectiveness.

Oconee County Water Use Schedule:

Odd-numbered addresses - Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays

Even-numbered addresses - Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays

No watering on Fridays
