### REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS CONSTRUCTION MANAGER AT RISK

#### OCONEE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ROCKY BRANCH WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY UPGRADE APRIL 10, 2008

The Oconee County Board of Commissioners is soliciting Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from contractors to perform management services for the construction of the upgrade to the County's Rocky Branch Water Reclamation Facility.

SOQ's must be returned in a sealed container marked on the outside with the project name and Company name. SOQ's will be received until 10:00 A.M. local time on Thursday, May 15, 2008 to the attention of Karen Barnett, Procurement Officer in the Oconee County Courthouse Purchasing Office, Finance Department at 23 North Main Street, Watkinsville, Georgia 30677. Any submittal received after this date and time will not be accepted. SOQ's will be publicly opened and only names of submitting firms will be read at 10:10 A.M. on Thursday May 15, 2008. A list of submitting firms will be available on May 16, 2008 on Oconee County's website [www.oconeecounty.com](http://www.oconeecounty.com) or by calling the Oconee County Purchasing Office at 706-769-2944.

A pre-submittal conference will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, May 1, 2008 at the Oconee County Government Annex Building, 1291 Greensboro Highway, Watkinsville, Georgia 30677. The conference will include a tour of the existing Rocky Branch Land Application System. Attendance at the pre-submittal conference is required as part of the SOQ submittal.
