

Oconee County Water Use Rates – Effective April 1, 2008

At their regular meeting of March 4, 2008, the Oconee County Board of Commissioners unanimously adopted a new Water Conservation Rate Structure to be effective April 1, 2008, as presented by the County’s Citizen Drought Contingency Committee. The new rate structure approved imposes two (2) additional consumption tiers and does not affect Commercial consumption. Noted below are the current rates and the rates that will become effective April 1, 2008:
