Amy,

The Discover Storm Water booklets are what we distribute each year at 3rd Grade Ag Day. In 2018, we sent 730 home with students for 3rd Grade Ag Day on March 29 & 30 at the J. Phil Campbell Center in Watkinsville.

The Oconee Fall Festival at Rocket Field in downtown Watkinsville on October 22 cited attendance at 20,000 of which we feel confident we had direct conversations with at least 1,000 about environmental issues. We estimate brochure distribution at around 200. We also use these brochures at various educational opportunities during the year like the Chamber Business Expo and our America Recycles Day and Great American Cleanup booths at the Oconee Farmers Market in downtown Watkinsville. Total brochures used for these other events did not exceed 100 for 2018.

Our 2018 Rivers Alive event was again held at McNutts Creek at the Clarke/Oconee County line at old Hwy. 441. The event was from 8-noon on October 22, 2018. 34 volunteers picked up 16 bags of trash, 7 tires and various large items and other debris like 5 gallon buckets, metal rods, tarps, ropes, etc.

I will copy and leave the Adopt a Mile reports on your desk. The Oconee County Sheriff's Office started their new Litter Patrol Division in October 2018 and I will include the monthly reporting form they are using. That program is gaining momentum and I expect 2019 monthly reports to be pages long!
