Project Update

Since our last newsletter in June 2018, the design teams have been working to complete draft preliminary designs of the US 441 corridor improvements. The teams have also completed the environmental surveys for Ecology and History and completed the initial field work for Archaeology. The underground and overhead Utilities surveys have also been completed. The public can now review the projects and provide comment at in-person open houses and an online survey.

After preliminary plans are complete, GDOT will begin to acquire right-of-way for the project followed by geotechnical investigations, final design, and construction. Construction of the projects is expected to occur no sooner than 2022.
