The Teacher Reuse Store is a unique collaboration of business, industry, non-profits and government that work together to collect usable materials that may have otherwise been discarded, and offer them to local teachers and schools at no cost. This project supports REUSE, reduces the amount of waste disposed of in our landfill, and also supports our local educational community.

Shopping: Materials are free to teachers from participating counties on a first-come first-served basis, with valid teacher ID.

The Teacher Reuse Store strives to maintain a variety of items including:

Classroom supplies:

- Educational posters and displays
- Workbooks, textbooks, and lesson plans
- Clerical and general office supplies
- File folders, 3-ring binders
- Paper, pencils, pens, crayons, stickers
- Desktop organizational supplies
- Art supplies of all kinds

Unusual & creative reuse items:

- Glass bottles
- Science equipment
- Bottle caps & metal lids
- Soda can pop tops
- Corks
- Expired/Used Gift Cards

Furniture:

- Shelving/Bookcases
- **Small** Desks
- Chairs
- **Small** File Cabinets

The Teacher Reuse Store is open for donations and teacher “shopping” throughout the year. Teachers must have a valid public, private, or home school teacher ID from a participating county to shop. Donations are welcome from all.

Donations: Discards from Businesses, industry, remodels, graduations and retirements are all great sources of materials!

We encourage donors to rethink your “waste” for creative reuse for underfunded classrooms in our communities.

The Teacher Reuse Store can accept a variety of items including traditional and non-traditional office supplies, misprints, outdated company promo items, partial cuts of paper.

Items not necessarily viewed as usable become valuable resource when accumulated and put in the hands of creative minds (think thousands of pop tops, bottle caps, packing peanuts, or industrial overs or scraps). Items can be used for arts and crafts, math counters, science experiments, or storytelling.
