

Sec. 50-328 - Regulation of wireless infrastructure in a county right-of-way.

*Stealth technology* means state-of-the-art design techniques used to blend objects into the surrounding environment and to minimize visual impact. These design techniques may be applied to wireless communications towers, antennas, and other facilities, which blend the proposed facility into the existing structure or visual backdrop in such a manner as to render it less visible to the casual observer. Such methods include, but are not limited to facilities constructed to resemble light poles, flag poles or other streetscape amenities. The use of additional features such as flags, decorative street lamps and banners or signs may be utilized to blend the proposed facility into the visual backdrop. This terminology is intended to be consistent with 'Alternative tower and antenna structure' as defined in section [333.02](#) [335.02](#) of the Unified Development Code of Oconee County and to accomplish the same purpose of improving the aesthetic appearance of the county.
